CSIR-SERC organizes Health Screening Camp for Women

The Swasth Nari, Sashakt Parivar Abhiyaan is a nationwide health initiative inaugurated by the Prime Minister of India, Shri Narendra Modi. The initiative is focused on improving the health and nutrition of women and children across India. In this connection, a one-day health screening camp was organised at CSIR campus on 18 December 2025 in association with Kauvery Hospital, Chennai.

The camp was formally inaugurated by Dr. N. Anandavalli, Director, CSIR-Structural Engineering Research Centre (CSIR-SERC) and Co-ordinating Director CSIR Madras Complex (CMC). In her inaugural address, she stressed on the importance of health for women who play a pivotal role not only in their respective

families but also in the society at large. Dr. Mahesh Kumar, Medical Superintendent, Kauvery Hospitals expressed his happiness to be associated with CSIR-SERC and CMC in organizing the health camp. He further reiterated the importance of prevention before cure and the necessity for screening tests which would help in providing timely and preventive care.

The health camp had active participation from the women staff members (permanent, temporary, housekeeping staff and students) of CSIR-SERC and CMC and female family members of other staff. BMI, RBS, BMD, ECG, ECHO, MAMMO, PFT were some of the screening tests organized during the camp. In addition, eye and dental check-ups was also made available. The staff also availed Doctors consultations on Obstetrics and Gynaecology during the camp.
